Life in the Kingdom Curriculum Overview

Life in the Kingdom includes **9 lessons** organized into three foundational rhythms of Kingdom living:

Trust • Listen • Respond

Each section builds on the previous one, helping children grow in their relationship with God.

Trust (Lessons 1–3)

Children begin by learning that they can **trust God and His Truth**.

These lessons help establish a foundation of faith and confidence in God's character.

Lesson 1: Trust God

Children learn that God is good and trustworthy.

Lesson 2: Trust God's Truth

Children discover that God's Word is true and can guide their lives.

Lesson 3: Trust God's Thoughts

Children learn that God's thoughts and ways are higher and better than our own.

Listen (Lessons 4–6)

Children learn that God still speaks today and that the **Holy Spirit helps guide us**.

Lesson 4: God Gives Us the Holy Spirit

Children discover that the Holy Spirit is our helper.

Lesson 5: We Can Hear God

Children learn simple ways God speaks to us.

Lesson 6: Take Time to Listen

Children practice slowing down and listening for God.

Respond (Lessons 7–9)

Children learn how to **live out their relationship with God** through love and obedience.

Lesson 7: Remain in God's Love

Children learn that staying connected to Jesus helps us live the life God designed for us.

Lesson 8: You Have a Role in the Kingdom

Children discover that God created them with a unique purpose and gifts.

Lesson 9: Use Your Role to Love Others

Children learn how to use their gifts to serve and bless people around them.

The Big Picture

Throughout the curriculum, children are encouraged to develop the rhythms of Kingdom life:

Trust God

Listen to the Holy Spirit

Respond to God's love

These rhythms help children begin building a **real and growing relationship with God**.
